

have all these people have a CDL. And the restrictions are there, so he can't do any more than what the restrictions allow him to do, nor to get the work done. It's absolutely essential that these people do not have to have a full CDL in order to carry these chemicals and fertilizers and so on. As I said before, they are restricted, and federal government allows each state to act accordingly. And I hope you will support the amendment also. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. Senator Schmitt.

SENATOR SCHMITT: Yes, Mr. Speaker, members, on the Coordsen amendment now I will support this, because in the rural area there's a lot of farmers and different people that like to work this seasonal occupation. And even though I opposed the semi bill, I will support him on this one. Thank you.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body, I was sorting through my bills here and I was trying to decide if we were debating 717 with Senator Chambers or if we were debating this bill of Coordsen's, and I guess I come to the conclusion after the other people spoke that apparently we are back on the Coordsen bill and so I guess given that situation I will rise to support Coordsen's amendment to allow these restricted CDL licenses because as has been said, there are many people out in the rural areas who don't have, who don't need to take that much training to get a regular CDL but can do with this size vehicle job that needs to be done, so I rise in support of the amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Kristensen, again some questions if I may so I can better understand what's going on here. First of all, this is an exemption provision that covers four or five different pages and has lots of new material in it apparently. Was this a bill in your committee?
