Mr. Clerk.

CLERK:      31 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The committee amendments are adopted. Senator Horgan, for opening on the bill, itself

SENATOR HORGAN: Thank you, Madam President and members. As the committee amendments became the bill, I would simply move for the adoption of the bill. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Horgan. Does anyone wish to address the bill, itself? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Horgan? Closing is waived. We will now vote on the motion to advance LB 203. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK:      36 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of LB 203.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 203 is advanced. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK:      Madam President, Business and Labor Committee, chaired by Senator Abboud reports LB 835 to General File with committee amendments, and LB 836 as indefinitely postponed. Those signed by Senator Abboud. Senator Kristensen has amendments to LB 570 to be printed. That is all that I have, Madam President. (See pages 1810-11 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Next is LB 717.

CLERK:      Madam President, 717 was a bill originally introduced by Senator Chambers and others. (Read title.) The bill was discussed yesterday.
