

reporting abuse, and to make the bill consistent with state law, we are making that change, adding the word "child" to "abuse," that's the first change. And I believe Senator Wesely may have a couple, an amendment as well, to make certain that this section does...is coordinated with existing law on child abuse, but that's the first change. The second change was just a...was really a mistake that we made on Select File in that we did not strike a section of the bill dealing with juvenile courts which I wanted to strike and there was just a mistake in how that was dealt with, and we did not actually strike it, even though I thought we had. So, essentially, those are the amendments, Mr. President, and they are very technical in nature and reflect the debate that we had the other day.

SENATOR HALL PRESIDING

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Ashford. Is there any discussion on the motion to return LB 629 to Select File for purposes of specific amendment? Any discussion? ASSISTANT CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to adopt the amendment.
