CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the committee...

SPEAKER BAACK: The committee amendments to LB 237 are adopted. We are now on the bill. Senator Bromm, would you like to open on the bill?

SENATOR BROMM: Mr. Speaker, I pretty well have opened on the bill, I think, when I discussed the amendment to the committee amendments and, therefore, I'll simply urge the body to advance the bill as amended. If there would be any other comments or questions we'd be happy to try to get the answers. I just simply ask the bill be moved. I think we do need it. We do have a June 30, 1993 deadline sunset on the fund as it is now. I think it is imperative that we do move the bill through with the emergency clause to advance beyond that June 30 deadline, so, thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Bromm. Mr. Clerk, an amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Bernard Stevens had an amendment printed. I have a note that he wishes to withdraw.

SPEAKER BAACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: That's all that I have.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Jones.

SENATOR JONES: Mr. Chairman and members of the body, I rise in support of this bill too. In talking with a lot of the service people in my district they all think it's a problem and they think we should be doing something about it and I think Senator Bromm explained it so well that I won't go into any more detail on it, but I just rise and support it. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Jones. Any other discussion on the advancement of LB 237? Seeing none, Senator Bromm, do you wish to close? He waives closing. We will now vote on the advancement of LB 237. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.
