SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Robinson. Any other discussion on the advancement of LB 516? Seeing none, Senator Wickersham, do you wish to close?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Just very briefly, I want to emphasize again that the intent of the bill is to take those monies that are raised through the separate fund-raising activities away from the city budget, away from the Municipal Auditing Act, away from all accountability to the political subdivisions. Those are raised for...by what I think are private individuals essentially for private purposes, and that is the way they should be treated. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. You've heard the closing of LB 516. We will now vote on the advancement. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 516.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 516 advances. Items for the record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, a confirmation hearing report from Natural Resources. Amendments to be printed by Senator Hall to LB 395; Senator Chambers to LB 365; Senator Wesely to LB 816; Senator Crosby to LB 495. A new resolution offered by Senator Dierks and others. (Read brief explanation.) That will be laid over. Pursuant to that introduction, Mr. President, a communication from the Speaker. LR 90 being referred to the Reference Committee for referral to a Standing Committee for public hearing. That's all that I have, Mr. President. (See pages 1911-17 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We will pass over LB 639 and we will go to Select File, senator priority bills, LB 627.

CLERK: Mr. President, 627 is on Select File. The bill has been discussed on Select File on April 27. At that time, an amendment to the bill was adopted. Senator Witek offered an amendment to the bill. There was a division requested. The
