Those factors are in the bill now, and even though I don't completely agree with the boot camp idea, pursuant to the arrangement we had drawn up, I am not going to try to stop the bill to stop the boot camp, but there are some other things which definitely ought not be added to the bill. And the only way, in my opinion, that that can be prevented is to just discuss the bill for the eight hours, let the key introducer, who is Senator Abboud, invoke cloture. We will take a vote on whatever is before us at that time, then vote immediately to move the bill. Now that's the long way around, that's the slow way around, but that's the way it is going to be done. But in the meantime, since these other matters are before us, I think on the chance that something could happen,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...we ought to adopt this amendment that I am offering.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Abboud, followed by Senators Witek and Hohenstein. Senator Abboud. Senator Witek.
