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a plate, and you'd add it to it, yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, Senator Moore said 17.50, so now...

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: He was thinking about the \$2.50 that you add on when you register the vehicle.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. So we are talking about a...

SPEAKER BAACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...plate that costs \$15, a regular plate, now. Then \$24 would actually be \$9 more, \$9 more that you are getting, right?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: No,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: If it is \$15 now, and I want to raise it to 24, you said, you resented when I said you're at least as brilliant as Senator Moore, Senator Moore, how much is 24 minus 15?

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: Um-hmm...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: How much is it?

SENATOR MOORE: Nine.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Right. Senator Kristensen, I correct it, you are not as brilliant as Senator Moore. It is \$9, that's how much more it would be, and I am saying this because I'm trying to get in focus for us what we are doing on this bill and how we talk one way on some of these fees and we talk another way to justify a certain thing, but we won't follow that logic all the way through to a conclusion.

SPEAKER BAACK: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But I am not going to offer that amendment on General File.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Landis.
