SENATOR LINDSAY: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. We will be voting on the sixth portion of the committee amendment. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on adoption of that portion of the committee amendments.

SENATOR LINDSAY: That portion of the committee amendments is adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next portion I believe is the portion of the amendment that deals with the driver's license reinstatement provisions, Sections 1, 10, 13, and 15, if I am right, Senator?
