

SENATOR MOORE: Yes. Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, and you're trying to make up that full six point something million through these fees?

SENATOR MOORE: Yes, and you're mak...and it's that more because there is a several hundred thousand dollar cost for the vehicle and title registration, there's some other additional costs, but the problem pointer (inaudible).

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, if you're raising six point something million dollars through these increased fees, why are you going to raise this fee by a hundred percent and give that money to the General Fund?

SENATOR MOORE: Well, because of that amount of Cash Fund revenue that now is going to DMV, 650,000 of that, it previously went to the General Fund...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And you...

SENATOR MOORE: ...and so you have to make up the difference somewhere.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And you say this 50 dollar increase is going to raise \$600,000?

SENATOR MOORE: That is the...that is the estimate, yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And that's based on figures from the past?

SENATOR MOORE: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And you accept that?

SENATOR MOORE: Yes. I...I...there...there...I would assume and when you assume I know what it does to you and me.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I understand.

SENATOR MOORE: I would assume that there would be some drop-off by doubling that fee in the amount of reinstatements, though I don't know, I think that would be very nominal.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So 50 thou...I mean \$50 was bringing in
