Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: I was in college and it wasn't \$50. I remember I had to wait an extra week before a paycheck came before I could get my...get the money to reinstate it.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So you're aware that it's not always at a person's fingertips, the amount needed to have a license reinstated?

SENATOR MOORE: I'm aware of what a high priority it becomes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Members of the Legislature, there are people who work for a living. Senator Moore was going to college which is an admirable pursuit, but we can see all it got him. All he is is a member of the Nebraska Legislature (laughter), but there's life after the Legislature and he will go on to that after this point because he's still a very young man. But isn't it kind of disappointing to see a man as young, as strong and vibrant as Senator Moore looking like he's beaten, crestfallen, frogs in his throat, barely hanging on. Senator Moore, it's only eight-thirty, suppose we had to go till midnight. What would you do? Get a drink of water and maybe try to perk up a little bit, take an aspirin or two?

SENATOR MOORE: I just...I'd just take more medicine.
