

necessary to do it. Too, they also furnish the counties with certificates of registration forms that would be a uniform, consistent form, and also pay the costs of the new driver's license system that will be operational and we're replacing things such as cameras. Section 18 is the operative date which is July 1st of this year, the start of the fiscal year. Section 19 has the various repealers from sections that were changed. And Section 20 does have the emergency clause. I would yield the balance of my time for Senator Moore to elaborate any more on the intent language.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: Since Senator Kristensen really is more brilliant than I am, I will just leave it at that.

SPEAKER BAACK: Any other discussion on this portion of the committee amendments? Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, and, Senator Moore, I'm going to kind of join you. This part of the bill isn't even worth discussing.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Kristensen, do you wish to close?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Mr. Speaker, I finally, I think, have beaten Senator Chambers into submission. I suppose if I say that he raised the white flag, that he probably would not think much of that so I will just urge the adoption of this portion of the amendment. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. We will now vote on this portion of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted on this final portion of the committee amendment? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of that portion of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER BAACK: The final portion of the committee amendments has been adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further pending to the bill, Mr. President.
