But what is understood is that we will continue to battle on Select File. Time may be on my side but not the way it was before we did have our little meeting and come to some kind of an agreement. And it was an agreement which Senator Moore and Senator Kristensen won. If I had won, I would be telling you, I would. I would be exalting. I would be telling you how we played a chess game and I beat them. But when you lose, you lose. And if I said I won, and you can see that I lost, what sense does that make for me?

SPEAKER BAACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: They won 8.9 percent of a total of nine, one dollar. I don't know of anybody who would think that one dollar was a great amount. There are some kids, you can offer them a dollar and they would tell you what to do with it. A dollar just doesn't go very far anymore and it certainly doesn't go very far in the Legislature. But because of the kinds of things that are in this tax increase bill, I must vote against it.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Hohenstein.

SENATOR HOHENSTEIN: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, just very briefly. Senator Chambers, I...you know, I listened to what you just said and I feel sort of sorry for you because I...I agree with you that you only won...you only won one dollar but you won it a million and a half times. You won that a million and a half times today, so don't feel so bad. It's not just one dollar, it's a million and a half dollars. And if Tom Osborne went on the field with one player against the legions of Oklahoma and Miami and won a game, we would think it was great and that's what you did today. So don't feel bad, you did good. The bill ought to be advanced nonetheless.
