LB 397A, 832

SENATOR LINDSAY: Discussion on LB 397A? Senator Hall, would you like to close? Senator Hall waives closing. We will vote on the advancement of LB 397A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no.

SPEAKER BAACK PRESIDING

SPEAKER BAACK: Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 397A.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 397A advances. We'll now go to LB 832.

CLERK: Mr. President, 832 was a bill introduced by the Appropriations Committee at the request of the Governor. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on March 17. It was referred to the Judiciary Committee. The committee amendments were offered. There were committee amendments. The committee amendments were offered by Senator Lindsay, as Chair of the committee. There was a division with respect to the committee amendments. I believe when the Legislature left the bill they were discussing the committee amendment relating to the sunset day. Does that...

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Moore, would you kind of update us where we are on this bill and then we'll proceed from there.

SENATOR MOORE: If I understand the sun...this is the sunset portion of the fee increase, and, as amended, it would sunset the fee increase 1997, the way it...'97? Okay, and in '97 we'll revisit the issue. I...this part of the amendment is fine now.

SPEAKER BAACK: Discussion on this portion of the committee amendments? Senator Abboud, you're up on this portion. Okay, we will wait just one second. We need to verify something on an amendment. We are now on the sunset portion of the committee amendments as that has been amended. Does anyone wish to speak to that portion of the committee amendments? Seeing no one, Senator Moore, do you wish to close on that portion?

SENATOR MOORE: No, Senator Lindsay.

SPEAKER BAACK: Oh, Judiciary. Senator Lindsay.
