

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker, how much time do I have?

SPEAKER BAACK: You've got a minute and 15 seconds.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And how far down would I be on the Speaker's list?

SPEAKER BAACK: Second.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Then I will concede that time but I will say this much. We have reached an accord on this amendment that I have offered to the committee amendments and Senator Moore, again, as yesterday, is going to grant me at least temporarily one dollar. (Laughter.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: Oh, Senator Chambers, the dollar man. Just call him George over there, beats me out of a dollar yesterday, beats me out of a dollar today. Simply, I will support Senator Chambers' amendment, move the bill to Select File at \$2. There is something in the works of a possibility that Senator Lindsay and Senator Wickersham are working on that may generate adequate amount of revenue to fund the project. If that falls through, I certainly reserve the right to try and come back in on Select File and raise the court fee to the amount that is necessary to fund the program. So let's move it at two today.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Moore. Senator Chambers. Anyone else wishing to speak to the Chambers amendment? Seeing no one, Senator Chambers, do you wish to close?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, I would just ask that you adopt this amendment. And, so that the body will understand what is happening, this system of automation probably is something that will be beneficial. I have been persuaded of that. So what we're working on now is trying to find the best source of revenue, and by best source we don't mean just where can we get the money, but a source that is associated with the activities that are to be undertaken while not...I'm going to try to use gentle terminology this morning, while not putting burdens on people who perhaps are not directly enough involved to have to bear that burden. So this is a temporary expedient by all of us who are discussing this to get the bill changed and then move it. Senator Moore wanted \$4. I
