

thing you have to remember is that federal law has mandated that by January 1, '96 you have to have a system like this. And so January 1, '96 you have to have a system like this so we said '95, we might as well get going, might as well save the money, dismantle the whole system and you have to understand the only way you're going to save that amount of money is to have fewer employees doing data entry. It's important that it's not, I mean, you're talking about eliminating people in DMV now doing that data entry. So I think January 1, '95 is a sufficient time. For one, we can come back next year and make a decision as to whether we're on track. If we're not on track, I, for one, will stand here and move that date back, but no further than '96. I think we ought to move the bill as it is in '95. Everybody knows we've got to get the system going, dismantle the old system. We can dismantle the old system. What we're really talking about is having fewer employees do data entry. And so having said that, understanding that at some point in time the feds are going to make us do this. Let's get it up and running by January 1, '95, if possible, and experience the savings as soon as possible. So, with that, I'd ask for advancement of the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK PRESIDING
