PRESIDENT MOUL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT MOUL: (Microphone not activated) ...George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain today is Pastor C. Vanderstoep, retired Lutheran Minister from Arlington, Nebraska in Senator Robinson's district. Pastor Vanderstoep.

PASTOR VANDERSTOEP: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Pastor Vanderstoep. I now call to order the seventy-eight day of the Ninety-Third Legislature, First Session. We will proceed with roll call. Please record your presence.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: No corrections, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The Journal is approved. Are there any messages, reports or announcements?

CLERK: Your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports they have carefully examined engrossed LB 583 and LB 583A and find both correctly engrossed. Those are signed by Senator Hohenstein. And I received a report from the Department of Roads. That will be on file in the Clerk's office. That's all that I have, Madam President. (See pages 2150-51 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. The next item on the agenda is General File. The first bill is LB 827.

CLERK: Madam President, LB 827 was a bill introduced by Senator Wesely. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 21 of this year. At that time, it was referred to the Health Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Madam President and members of the Legislature, pleased to present to you LB 827 and the committee amendments do
