SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President, members of the Legislature, Senator Lynch called an item to my attention in the repealer clause and I was looking at the various statutes that are mentioned and it mentions in the repealer clause, 16-323, as being repealed. I haven't had a chance to go through the rest of them, but I'm wondering if because of the language, the new language that is put in these sections, and some may be general, that it would apply also to first class cities. So if the amendment is adopted I will have the opportunity to see why the repealer clause was drafted in the manner that it is, but it was drafted by the Bill Drafter with an explanation of the purpose of extending the provisions of LB 717 throughout the state. So, at this point, because of the new language they're putting into sections that they have amended, I'm going to leave the amendment as it is without removing anything from the repealer clause at this point. I hope you will adopt the amendment. Then I will discuss some of the points that Senator Hall raised with reference to the bill itself.
