

we'll work with them and we'll try to fix it. I think if we do this, it should remove all doubt. If people have concerns about what we're doing, I would be glad to address that with them. If not, I would urge the adoption of this amendment and correct what was done on the rules of the road.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. Discussion of the amendment by Senator Kristensen? Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Kristensen, I was trying to read and listen at the same time. This restores the law exactly to what current law is?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Any further discussion? Seeing none, Senator Kristensen, do you wish to close?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Just real briefly, Mr. Speaker, and I want to make sure that everybody understands what we're doing is that there was an amendment put to the rules of the road that now has an issue of its applicability and the way it was drafted that it is going to cause us some problems, I believe. We certainly don't want to have that happen and instead of trying to patch it we just want to completely take it out and leave the current law as it is. With that, I would urge the adoption of this amendment. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. We will now vote on the Kristensen amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted on the amendment? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Kristensen's amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Kristensen's amendment is adopted.
