SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is withdrawn. We are...we are still working on the motion to advance, because we did have that motion in front of us. Senator Jones, did you wish to speak to that?

SENATOR JONES: Mr. Chairman and members of the body, I just wanted to talk just a little bit more about that rails to trail bill, because I called the radio station in Gordon, Friday, for my news report, and they said that they was going to have a talk show on the radio this morning and have call-in people. And they haven't found anybody that was in favor of it up there right now. So, in fact, I haven't got no phone calls, or nobody in favor of it. They want a railroad up there. And it's hard to change it over to a trail if you don't have no support in your district. So thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Jones. Senator Beutler, on the advancement.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, I don't want to get into a long discussion on this bill again. I think you will recall, though, that earlier on Select File we did everything that anybody asked for in terms of criticism of the proposition. We changed the fencing provisions, we changed the facilities provision, we provided for leasing of all of the land to adjacent property owners if it's not used for any other purpose. So I think we've accommodated all of the interests, to the extent that they can be accommodated. Now we're down to the simple, basic question, and certainly would recommend your support of taking up the corridor and be sure that it's held together. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Vrtiska.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body. Senator Beutler, could I bother you for a question?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yes, sir.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Of course, one of the problems that I have, and I think I addressed it before, has to do with the Game Commission taking over more property when they, in fact, last year were talking about closing 30 some of their parks. And I
