

I think correcting a situation that arose by the passage of LB 1 in the second special session. Senator Withem is absolutely correct that there was the effort made at that time to change the rebate provisions into an exemption. I will say that whether it was inadvertence or other causes that the fact that depreciable repairs and parts might not be adequately addressed by that exemption process can now be corrected. We'll simply go back to a rebate system, it will guarantee that they go on to the personal property tax rolls. Those who are willing to apply will get their rebates, it's as simple as that. And I think it's a fair policy statement for this body to make.
