

SENATOR MOORE: That would be my...my answer to that would be yes.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Thank you.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Is there anyone further wishing to speak on the committee amendments to LB 330? If not, Senator Moore to close on the committee amendments.

SENATOR MOORE: I'd simply move that the committee amendments be adopted.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Thank you, Senator Moore. Question is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 330. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: Mr. President, I'd ask for a call of the house and would accept call-in votes.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Thank you. Question is, should the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 22 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

SENATOR LINDSAY: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Ask all the senators to return to the floor and record their presence. The house is under call. All senators please return to the floor and record your presence. Senator Haberman has requested a roll call vote. While we are waiting, I would call your attention to the south balcony. Senators Bohlke, Senator Chambers, Senator Day. The house is under call. Senator Landis, could you check in, please. Senator Bohlke and Senator Day, the house is under call. And Senator Chambers. Senator Moore, Senator Bohlke is on her way and she is here. We will proceed with a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk.
