

forfeiture that probably has an effect on the way we should draft the asset forfeiture portion of that amendment. So I'm just going to briefly conclude that because I would like to see additional study on certain proposed amendments, because this bill does nothing until 1996 anyway, and because we have other legislation that we need to turn our attention to, I do feel that it's proper to wait with this bill until next year. And so I'm going to leave my amendment run and we'll see what the wish of the body is.
