

that's fine and maybe that makes more sense just in terms of giving somebody a free hand in negotiation. But by the same token when you do that, you do two things. You've cut down on the delegation language and, therefore, increased the danger that the delegation to the Governor will be unconstitutional and too, you've loosened the reins on the Governor in a way that you might find unsatisfactory in the future. Senator Chambers, we have done a lot in terms of degrading ourselves in the area of gambling perhaps, certainly from your point of view. But I would also suggest to you that the Bible also says that heaven rejoices more over one sinner who repents than over all the others.

PRESIDENT MOUL: One minute.

SENATOR BEUTLER: And this is not a matter of repenting but this is a matter of saying we've made some decisions in here about how far we're going with gambling and we want everybody...we want that decision to be coherent and we want it to be a legislative decision and as a Legislature we want to put together what we're doing for all the people whether they're Indians or blacks or whites, put everything together in a logical and fair manner under, as best we can, a unified system of law. And if we make the laws for everybody else, we ought to do the best we can to see that the law that we make with regard to our relationship to the Indian tribes is integrated and appropriately a part of the rest of the law that we make in here. Thank you.
