ASSISTANT CLERK: (Roll call vote taken.) The vote is 21 ayes, 27 nays on the adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment fails. Senator Hohenstein.

SENATOR HOHENSTEIN: I'd move that LB 231 be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MOUL: You've heard the motion to advance. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. LB 231 is advanced. Next is LB 815.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Madam President, with respect to LB 815, Senator Warner would move to return the bill. The amendment is on page 2528.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Madam President, members of the Legislature, this is an amendment to 815 which was described as a little more than an E & R amendment. It is to correct some internal inconsistencies on references within the bill and, secondly, it moves one of the provisions, one of the amendments that was adopted on Select File to a different section. It makes no substantive change whatsoever but it was needed to have the correct internal references. I'd move the bill be returned to Select File for the adoption of the corrective amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Warner. Does anyone wish to speak to this motion? Seeing none, we will now vote on the motion to return. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return the bill.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The motion is adopted. We are at Select File. Senator Warner, for opening on the amendment.

SENATOR WARNER: Madam President, I just move the adoption of the amendment.
