Specialization is something that I think you do repetition to make you specialized and you do the same thing over and over again. As far as it being a business, I know different medical agencies and units that look if they have budget personnel, they have bill collectors and, believe me, they have professional help when it comes time to make out their internal revenue forms. We also have out-of-state companies that own nursing homes. We have visiting specialists that come into our communities and help with things where we don't have a specialist there to take care of it. So I think the argument that someone from out of state or that there is something wrong with there being somewhat of a profit margin at these clinics is something that's not out of the norm, nor is it not done by other medical professions and agencies throughout the state. With that said, I'd like to go to the amendment that Senator Bohlke has offered and to stress the fact that what we're all looking for is good information, the distribution of that information and how it would come about and who does it. Number one, we're looking at over and over what is referred to and I would look at especially on page 7 is the department and the department is the State Department of Health, which I think has a lot of expertise, a lot of knowledge when it comes to providing information on a multiple of other subjects in this state, when it refers to health preventative measures in looking at good health and also things that need to be done after the fact. The department that would look at the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists that would help in looking at the accuracy of this material I think is very appropriate. They are the pros.
