Now these health centers are located throughout the State of Nebraska and they have regional offices and they provide services in satellite cities and if you started in eastern Nebraska there is Tecumseh that also has satellite services and Beatrice, Falls City and Peru. You have Lincoln. You have Omaha. You have Fremont that also provides services in Columbus and Norfolk. You have Grand Island that provides services also in Kearney. You have Hastings. You have Broken Bow that has services in Ainsworth, Arcadia, Cedar Rapids, O'Neill and Lexington. You have North Platte that also provides services in McCook, Ogallala; Chadron, Nebraska, who provides services also in Alliance; and Scottsbluff that provides services in Sidney.
