Finally, let me say that there is a focus on regulation and control as opposed to support. And if we can promote information to women in a way that says we support women, that's very, very different than saying, you've got to do what we say you have to do.

SPEAKER BAACK: Time.

SENATOR RASMUSSEN: I thank Senator Hohenstein for my time and my guess is I didn't say a lot of things that he agrees with but I appreciate it. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Rasmussen. Seeing no other lights on, Senator Bohlke, would you like to close?

SENATOR BOHLKE: Yes. Mr. Speaker and members, I bring you good news. June 1st, floor of the Legislature in Lincoln, Nebraska, those people who have been labeled pro-choice and those senators who have been labeled pro-life have come to a compromise and an agreement, one that will allow this piece of legislation, LB 110, to move forward. I think that those of you who have been involved with this compromise certainly have my thanks and my gratitude. It has been an interesting process. The last time we all sat here and talked about this issue in a manner and at a level that we had never shared before, it took a while before we wanted to talk about it again. But immediately following, someone from the press asked me if I felt rejected. And I said, no, I didn't feel rejected because I thought we had a new beginning. Well, I think tonight is the proof that we do have a new beginning. It is a time that I think is very special for the entire State of Nebraska because since the beginning of that night, at that night and that discussion and that sharing between the senators here on the floor we have been able to move forward. Senator Rasmussen earlier today in this discussion read off all the points upon which we found we could agree. I think that probably that's the first time in a long time that we have been able to stand on the floor on a topic such as this and say, here's the list of things we would like to show you that we have reached agreement. Here are the things that all of us can share and believe and have the same goals. Here are the things that all of us hope that a good piece of legislation will attain. I said that in the beginning Senator Lindsay had said to me that his main goal was to provide good information and
