SENATOR JONES: Okay, thank you.

SENATOR PIRSCH: Thank you.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Jones. Is there any other discussion on the Pirsch amendment? Seeing none, the question is the adoption of the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Pirsch's amendment.

SENATOR HALL: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Senator Beutler would move to amend. Senator, I have AM1941 in front of me.

SENATOR HALL: Senator Beutler on the amendment.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Hall and members of the Legislature, this is a minor amendment responding in part to General File debate and also incorporating into the bill a small bill that we heard and advanced without dissent from Natural Resources Committee, LB 773, which has to do with fees for nonresident turkey permits and private fish and minnow hatchery permit fees. The amendment is on 2548 of your Journal and you can look at it there. Basically these two fees haven't been changed I think for about twenty years. And one of them, the wild turkey hunting permit fee, goes from \$35 to \$50 and the private fish hatchery or minnow fishery permit is increased from \$20 to \$50. Beyond that, the only other thing that this amendment does is to regulate the percent of increase that the Game and Parks can increase fees in the bill so that only by 6 percent a year can they be increased. They cannot be increased all at once, and that was in response to General File debate. Would ask the adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Any discussion on the Beutler amendment to LB 235? Seeing none, the question is shall the amendment be adopted? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on the Beutler amendment to LB 235. Have you all voted? This is the turkey amendment as offered by Senator Beutler. Record, Mr. Clerk.
