You need to think sometimes and put yourself in somebody else's situation. I can, I could pay the amount and go to that park if I wanted to go. But I don't say because I can do it...

SENATOR HALL: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...everybody can. And when there's some special interest group that you all are concerned about you say different things. I remember all the times that I voted for those people who put that money in Commonwealth, and people I know don't even have that kind of money to put anywhere. And I didn't say all the things that other people were saying, they were greedy and they were trying to get the higher interest rates so I'm not going to support the thing. And it would have been much easier for me to be flippant about that than it is about these fees. But I'm going to say about, to Senator Beutler what this young guy said when Job was in his trouble and all these people were condemning him and saying he had to do something wrong or this wouldn't have happened. This young man said, I won't say the things you're saying because it may not be that way. Then old Job said, if you were situated as I am, I wouldn't do you like you're doing me.

SENATOR HALL: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I wouldn't talk down to you like you're talking down to me. And I didn't do to those you care about what you're doing to those I care about.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Beutler, you're next, followed by Senator Bromm, Jones, Baack, and Hillman. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr...Senator Hall and members of the Legislature, I don't feel that in the State of Nebraska that we have been insensitive to any of the people who use the parks. I think we've been very sensitive to everybody. The park system is 56 percent cash funded. That means that 44 percent comes from federal funds, comes from federal income taxes, comes from state income taxes. The people who pay merely, who only pay the user fees are only paying a portion, less than half really, of the cost of maintaining the facilities that they use because
