

SENATOR HALL: Debate is ceased. Senator Fisher, to close on your amendment.

SENATOR FISHER: Yes, just quickly, I think we've had debate. Again, I apologize for not having the opportunity to bring this bill in the correct or the usual procedure and we've used this type of a procedure to get it amended on. I think we've heard the pros and cons and just ask you to vote and support this amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Fisher. You've heard the closing on the amendment by Senator Fisher to LB 724. Those in favor of adopting the amendment vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk. Senator Fisher. Senator Fisher, I'm sorry. Senator Fisher, would you repeat that please.

SENATOR FISHER: Yes, I ask for a roll call vote.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you. I'd remind members we are on Final Reading. If you could return to your seats. We've had a request for a roll call vote. And there has been a request that members check in, if you would please record your presence prior to the roll call. Those members who are outside the Chamber, if you would return to the Chamber and record your presence. We are on Final Reading. Senator Schimek, if you could record your presence. Thank you. Senator Pirsch, Senator Hillman, too. Mr. Clerk, call the roll on the adoption of the amendment by Senator Fisher.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote. See pages 2650-51 of the Legislative Journal.) 33 ayes, 13 nays on the amendment.

SENATOR HALL: The amendment is adopted. Senator Hohenstein, to advance the bill.

SENATOR HOHENSTEIN: I'd move that LB 724 be readvanced to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR HALL: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed. The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Beutler would move to return.

SENATOR HALL: Senator Beutler, to open on the motion to return.
