SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Abboud. Mr. Clerk, amendments to the amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first amendment to the amendment is Senator Abboud, AM1556.

SENATOR HALL: Senator Abboud.

SENATOR ABOUD: I'd like to withdraw that amendment.

SENATOR HALL: Withdrawn.

CLERK: Senator Schimek has the next amendment.

SENATOR HALL: Senator Schimek, on your amendment to the amendment. Is anyone authorized to carry the amendment for Senator Schimek? Let's move to the next amendment, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Withem has the next motion, Mr. President.

SENATOR HALL: Senator Withem. Is anyone authorized to carry Senator Withem's motion? If not, let's roll over that as well.

CLERK: Senator Lindsay has the next motion.

SENATOR HALL: Senator Lindsay withdraws it.

CLERK: I have nothing further, other than the two we've passed over, Mr. President.

SENATOR HALL: There is nothing further pending where members are present. Senator Withem, he pulls his as well. Senator Schimek is still not in the Chamber. We're back with the Landis amendment in front of us. Senator Coordsen, your light is next.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Only to reaffirm, Mr. President, what has already been said by the previous speaker. This is the final part of the divided Landis amendment. I would remind you, a conversation from back on General File, that the time of the drafting of 757, all of the statistical information had not been placed...not...was not available to us. It was still being priced by the national organization that does the rating. And the language that is in this part and the dollar benefits that are in this part are the result of that.
