SENATOR CHAMBERS: They got to pay.

SENATOR LANDIS: ..the Compensation Court shall establish and maintain a list of subscribers who wish to receive notice of public hearing on the question of adopting and promulgating any rule or regulation...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: They got to pay.

SENATOR LANDIS: ..and shall provide notice to subscribers at a cost to be assessed against each subscriber?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And what is the cost? It doesn't say. It can be anything the court wants and in the same way we raise fees willy-nilly here, this could be a source of revenue. What would be wrong really, since this is related to injured workers, of saying that...'cause there...how many county libraries are there? Is there one in each county or more?

SENATOR LANDIS: Let us assume 93 county libraries. I'm not sure there is a county library in Lancaster County because we have a system here, but...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And you all...

SENATOR LANDIS: ..let's assume 93.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, and you also have the Workers' Comp Court so it's right here in your hometown.

SENATOR LANDIS: That's true.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Right here in your old hometown.

SENATOR LANDIS: Yes, it is.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Now how about saying that the information would be disseminated to the county libraries? Is that too, too great a burden on this bill?

SENATOR LANDIS: If I understand, there is something that says what, at the library's request? If adding at the county library's request will end Senator Hall's amendment and your
