

would be distributed to the appropriate library in each of the 93 counties, whether it be the library system here in Lincoln or in Omaha, a library system that would exist in very likely Grand Island or any of the other counties that are out there. If they don't happen to have a per se county library, as long as the information would be disseminated and be available on a much more equitable geographic basis I believe that that would be enough for purposes of withdrawing this amendment or substituting some language to that effect and I would support that. And this is my last amendment. So, Senator Landis, if you have...

SENATOR LANDIS: If I could have just...oh, thank you. Perhaps the appropriate thing to do here is to allow us to draft that, move on to another amendment, come back and accept it. And if it says "Senator Hall describes" I'll be happy to endorse the amendment.

SENATOR HALL: I would have no objection of on that basis withdrawing this amendment.

SENATOR LANDIS: It is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have is from Senator Withem.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you. Senator Withem. I do not see Senator Withem in the Chamber. We'll stand at ease for just a moment as Senator Withem makes his presence. We'll pass over that amendment. Mr. Clerk, the next amendment.

ASSISTANT CLERK: The next amendment I have is from Senator Will.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Senator Will to open.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. President, I'd like to withdraw that amendment.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: It is withdrawn. The next amendment.

ASSISTANT CLERK: The next amendment that I have is from Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: That amendment is withdrawn as well.
