The overall impact of the state budget incorporated in the changes in 757 are that there's a small increase for FY '93-94 and then a significant reduction in '94-95 and thereafter. The significant reduction is \$1,260,000 in '94. The second year reduction will directly help with our current budget problems. In fact, this bill will help us out of our budget problems because it creates a cash fund agency out of workers' comp court based on some premium assessments that will be paid. Accordingly, expenditures from the comp court's cash fund and the workplace cash fund will increase by \$745,000 in '93-94 and \$2,795,000 in '94-95. These expenditures allow for additional people and operational expenses to implement 757. I would urge for the changes which are in the...which are brought to me by Legislative Fiscal to effectuate those ends. And in order to facilitate the necessary appropriations, General Fund reductions and fund transfers, these amendments are necessary. Thank you.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Any discussion on the Landis amendment? Seeing none, Senator Landis, would you like to close? Senator Landis waives closing. We'll now vote on the Landis amendment. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.
