SENATOR HALL: One minute.

SENATOR WILL: ...intend to pursue as vigorously as I can, certainly, and I look forward to working with those of you who are interested in actually making improvements in the way that we treat our citizens in the State of Nebraska because frankly, ladies and gentlemen, it's a crime. It's a crime that people in this state can be hurt by products through no fault of their own and we can't come in as a Legislature and correct that situation because of some outside interests that have influenced what is going on in the body. It's a crime, it's nothing less than that and the fact is it's something we ought to do and we ought to not be afraid to take that step and that's a step that we should take in 1994. Thank you.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Will. Mr. Clerk, you have a priority motion.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Will would move to bracket or ask unanimous consent to bracket the bill until January 1, 1994.

SENATOR HALL: No objection? So ordered. Next item on the agenda, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Just give me a moment, Mr. President. I'll be...

SENATOR HALL: Mr. Clerk, we'll move down the agenda to Item 8, Select File, committee priority bills, LB 348.

CLERK: Mr. President, 348, Select File, I have Enrollment and Review amendments, Senator, first of all.

SENATOR HOHENSTEIN: I'd move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 348.

SENATOR HALL: You've heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed. Amendments are adopted. Mr. Clerk.
