

CLERK: Mr. President, the first amendment I have to the bill is by Senators Withem, Baack and Bernard-Stevens, AM1541.

SENATOR HALL: Senator Withem, on the amendment. For those members who are outside the Chamber, there was a bracket motion that was adopted to LB 137. We're now dealing with LB 348 on Select File. We have the Withem amendment that is pending. Senator Withem, we are on 348 and your amendment is the first one. Senator Baack, would you like to be recognized on this amendment? Senator Baack.

SENATOR BAACK: Yes, Mr. Chairman and colleagues, I believe that I will make a motion to adjourn. I would like to say that I do appreciate the hard work that we've put in and I think we have accomplished a great deal and going into the final day we do not have any senator priority bills on Select File anymore.
