SPEAKER BAACK: Yes, Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Before we vote, I would ask for check in.

SPEAKER BAACK: A check in has been requested. We are on Final Reading. Members, please check in. Senator Landis, would you check in, please. Senator Moore, would you check in. Senator Pirsch, would you check in, please. We will now vote on the motion to reconsider. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 40 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to reconsider the Final Reading vote of LB 595 with the emergency clause attached.

SPEAKER BAACK: The motion is successful. We will now immediately proceed to a vote on LB 595 with the emergency clause attached. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Recoll vote read. See page 2708 of the Legislative Journal.) 37 ayes, 11 nays, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 595 passes with the emergency clause attached.

CLERK: Mr. President, a second priority motion. Senator Hall would move to reconsider the Final Reading vote of LB 22 with the emergency clause attached.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Mr. President, and members, again, it...I apologize for not being present at the time this vote was taken. I think it is important that both of these tax bills take effect at the same time and I would urge the body to duplicate the vote we just took and reconsider the emergency clause vote on LB 22.
