SPEAKER WITHEM PRESIDING

SPEAKER WITHEM: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen, and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Today's prayer will be offered by Harland Johnson, the Chaplain Coordinator for the Legislature.
