SPEAKER WITHEM PRESIDING

SPEAKER WITHEM: Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. This morning cur prayer will be offered by Chaplain Coordinator Harlan Johnson.

HARLAND JOHNSON: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Harland. Would members please record their presence. Mr. Clerk, then you can tell me whether there is a quorum presert or not.

CLERK: Mr. President, there is a quorum present.

SPEAKER WITHEM: See, I was right, there is. Do you have any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections this morning, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Any messages, reports or announcements?

CLERK: Just one item, an Attorney General's Opinion addressed to Senator Robinson. That will be inserted in the Legislative Journal. That's all that I have. (See pages 285-87 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Item 5 is the adoption of legislative resolutions. I'm sorry Senator Schimek isn't here for us to try out her new rule change here. The manner in which we are going to treat the grouping of resolutions, it was announced that these would be grouped. No individual had requested a separation so they will be treated as a group. (LR 290-292) The motion will be to adopt all four motions, resolutions with one single vote. We will recognize the introducer of each resolution separately for an explanation of the resolution. So with that, LR 290, Senator Robak.

SENATOR ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body, this resolution is a resolution to honor Fullerton, Fullerton, Nebraska, for the Nebraska Community Improvement Program. They won, Fullerton won the Hoiberg Award. The Hoiberg Award is named for Dr. Otto Hoiberg in recognition for his tireless efforts to stimulate community effort and awareness and action programs. This was implemented 30 years ago and the award is given to one Nebraska community improvement program each year.
