

SENATOR CROSBY PRESIDING

SENATOR CROSBY:        (Microphone not activated.) ...Norris Legislative Chamber. This is the forty-third day of the Ninety-third Legislature, Second Session. For our opening prayer today our chaplain for the day is Monsignor Ivan Vap, Rector of the Cathedral of the Risen Christ in Lincoln. Monsignor.

MONSIGNOR VAP:        (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Monsignor. Roll call.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Any messages, reports or announcements?

CLERK: Just one item and that's Senator Robak would like to print amendments to LB 1022. That's all that I have, Madam President. (See pages 1266-68 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. We will go to LB 1275.

CLERK: Madam President, 1275 was discussed yesterday by the Legislature. At that time, Enrollment and Review amendments were adopted. Senator Hartnett and Crosby amended the bill. Senator Withem had amendments that were adopted. When the Legislature adjourned, Senator Beutler had pending amendment AM3779, Senator. That's...and then, of course, you filed a new amendment this morning.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I did, Mr. Clerk, but I'm going to stick with this amendment.

CLERK: Okay.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Beutler, would you like to bring us up to date?

SENATOR BEUTLER: I would. Senator Crosby, members of the
