PRESIDENT ROBAK PRESIDING

PRESIDENT ROBAK: (Recorder not activated) ...George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. We are on our forty-eighth day today, in the Ninety-Third Legislative Session, Second Session. Our chaplain for the day is Pastor Robert Varner from the First Baptist Church in Falls City, in Senator Vrtiska's District. Pastor Varner.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you. Do we have any corrections to the Journal?

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Enrollment and Review respectfully reports they have carefully examined and reviewed LB 915 and recommend that same be placed on Select File, LB 1031, LB 1087, LB 1165, LB 1236, LB 1313, LB 1313A, LB 984, all on Select File, some of those having Enrollment and Review amendments attached. I have received a report from the Nebraska Department of Labor. That will be on file in the Clerk's Office.
