SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Schimek, we are in the middle of a vote so I think those questions could come a little later. Thank you.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: I'd request a call of the house.

SENATOR CROSBY: We have a request for a call of the house. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 11 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, to go under call.

SENATOR CROSBY: The house is under call. Would all senators please check in. Would all senators, who are unexcused, please return to the Chamber and record your presence, and would all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. We are looking for Abboud, Ashford, Senator Bernard-Stevens, Lindsay, Lynch, Matzke, Monen, Moore, Pedersen, Preister, Senator Robinson. Senator Warner, would you like to check in. Senator Landis, would you like to check in. Senator Kristensen. Senator Wickersham, would you like to...forget it, Senator Wickersham. We are a little confused, it's all right. We are voting on ceasing debate. Senator Schimek, would you like to take call-in votes? Thank you.

CLERK: Senator Kristensen voting yes. Senator Landis voting yes.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Haberman has requested a roll call vote, so we will have to wait for everybody to get here. Senator Lindsay, would you like to check in. Senator Bromm, would you like to check in. Senator Elmer, would you please return to the Chamber. Senator Monen, would you please return to the Chamber. Start the roll call, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote commenced. See page 1838 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CROSBY: (Gavel) Please keep your conversations down so that the Clerk may hear the answers.
