SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, members, very briefly I rise in support of the Chambers amendment. I don't have any problem with his amendment to the Schimek amendment, but I still oppose the Schimek amendment. I would ask you to oppose it as well. I think that we've adequately addressed some of the concerns, but this amendment has really no bearing on..unfortunately, the Chambers amendment does not strike the underlying Schimek amendment, but it does enhance the Schimek amendment, which would gut basically the section at hand.
