CLERK: Senator Wesely would move to amend the A bill. (See AM4477 found on page 1890 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Madam President and members. This reflects the amendments that we adopted on Select File. Currently the bill calls for about just under \$200,000 in General Fund expenditures next year; 43,000 would be for the waiver staff, to develop that; 113,000 would be needed for the staff and the operating cost to enhance the child support collection of the bill; and we need \$43,000 for the welfare ombudsman to oversee that function from the legislative branch. In addition, we have cash funds from the Department of Health of 99,000, and federal funding at 233,000. So the total funding is 531,000. Again, out of that about 200,000 would be General Fund. The funding for the following year is one, a little over one million dollars for the following fiscal year.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Any discussion on the Wesely amendment? Seeing none, all those in favor of the Wesely amendment to LB 1224A vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Please record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Wesely amendment is adopted. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: I would move for advancement of the bill to E & R engrossing.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Any discussion? Seeing none, all those in favor say aye. All those opposed nay. LB 1224A advances. LB 833A.
