

making an adjustment in income tax in the '95 session. You can eventually collect the money but you may be in the position where you have to have accelerated collection. You could increase the tax rate on sales tax which is what we're talking about now, but I don't think you can do that till after January 1 of 1995. Excuse me, yes, January 1 of 1995, of '96 rather because that's when this runs out. And I don't believe that you can have a sales tax in excess of, sales tax rate in excess of 7 percent. And for all practical purposes that source is tied up then through all of 1995. You're now then down to next session looking for additional revenue. Essentially you may need to generate it quickly and the only options you're going to have is expansion on sales tax on services. If that's the case, we just as well leave the services on that we've got here, it's not much, but it's a start and we'll put it right back on if the way things are going, may have to. I don't like it, but we may have to. And the other option, there are some other equally distasteful sources of additional revenue but I firmly believe that this body is boxing itself into a position a year from now that you're not going to like. And some of us are going to have to vote yes a year from now who aren't going to be happy about it, but we know the option of destroying much of the services that some of you want to advocate. Some of you have added even to this year's budget is the option we have. And I would certainly urge that you give careful thought before you go ahead and pass this bill to give away that tax source which inevitably is going to be needed in all likelihood a year from now for the options you're going to have you're going to dislike a great deal and I would urge at this point, I would vote for the bracket even though I have reservations because of the content of the bill originally, but the...
