PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Hall. The question before the body is the adoption of the Hall amendment to LB 961. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote nay.

SENATOR HALL: (Microphone not activated) ...for a call of the house and accept call-in votes.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: There is a request for a call of the house. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 24 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The house is under call. Will senators please return to their seats and check in. Will all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor, and we are accepting call-in votes. The house is under call.

CLERK: Senator Hartnett voting yes. Senator Janssen voting yes.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: There's been a request for a roll call vote. Senators, please check in. Senator Ashford, would you check in, please. Senator Wickersham, would you check in, please. Senator Moore, Senator Matzke, Senator Bohlke, Senator Rasmussen. Waiting for Senator Moore. Roll call vote. Please proceed, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call voted taken. See pages 1908-09 of the Legislative Journal.) 28 ayes, 11 nays on the amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Hall amendment is adopted. I raise the call. Anything further on the bill?

CLERK: Yes, Madam President. Senator Beutler, I understand you want to pass over yours, Senator, or is that not correct?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Clerk, I'd like to pass over all amendments I've failed and put them behind all amendments that all other persons have filed at this point.
