SPEAKER WITHEM: (Microphone not turned on.) ...George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. As we begin today, our fifty-seventh day of the sixty-day session, we have with us, from the First Presbyterian Church in Grand Island, Senator Fisher's district, we have Pastor Roger Nelson.

PASTOR NELSON: (Prayer offered.)

Item 6 on the agenda, the rationale of those three bills being on the agenda were that those are all three individual senator priority bills with amendments filed on those that go to the substance of the bill, not additions or other policy issues not contained within the bill. LB 1207, I have since learned, is a not...is not in need of the amendment that was originally filed, so it will not be on the agenda as we take up that consideration. So you should scratch LB 1207 from the agenda.
