SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, I thought you meant something like U-Haul, for Will-"Haul" the bill. But this is going to be EC stops the bill. (Laughter.) So, here's what I'm saying, if you don't...you don't really want the bill.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Well,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: If you had a choice between stripping the Hall-Will amendment or losing the bill, you would rather lose the bill, that's what I'm asking.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: No, I would sooner have the bill in the original form, but I...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: You're not going to get that.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: ...I know, we don't have enough time to do that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So then do you want to....Tell me what you want to do.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Well, I want the bill to move with the Hall-Will amendment at this time, and then we'll come back next year, Senator, and take a look at it again.
