SENATOR CHAMBERS:    Madam President, I will have to ask for a roll call because we did take a machine vote, so I stand corrected. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK:    Thank you, Senator Chambers. We will have a roll call vote when senators are here. Senator Bernard-Stevens, check in, please. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Senator Beutler, will you check in, please. Senator Landis, will you check in, please. Roll call vote.

CLERK:    (Roll call vote taken. See pages 1928-29 of the Legislative Journal.) 12 ayes, 15 nays, Madam President, on the amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK:    The Chambers amendment fails.

CLERK:    Madam President, Senator Chambers would move to indefinitely postpone the bill.

PRESIDENT ROBAK:    I raise the call. Senator Chambers.

CLERK:    Senator Schellpeper has the option to lay the bill over.

PRESIDENT ROBAK:    Senator Schellpeper.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Just lay it over, there's only five minutes, we don't have enough time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS:    Senator Schellpeper,...

PRESIDENT ROBAK:    Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS:    Madam President, I blink, I withdraw the motion.

PRESIDENT ROBAK:    Thank you, Senator Chambers. The motion is withdrawn. Anything further on the bill?

CLERK:    I have nothing further on the bill at this time, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK:    Senator McKenzie.
