next. Do you wish to continue speaking? Senator Hall, do you wish to close on your amendment, on your motion?

SENATOR HALL: Madam President and members, Senator Preister, thank you. With a little capers, some lemon, a little Dijon mustard and some egg, steak tartare will be ready in about 20 minutes for anyone who would care to have some. With that, I would urge adoption of the amendment. I would return to Select File first and then we can move forward.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Hall. Any further discussion of the motion to return to Select File? Seeing none, all those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the motion to return the bill.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 1243 returns to Select File. Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Madam President, I would move adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President, members of the Legislature, Senator Withem was going to try to get Senator Hall and Senator Preister to sit down in his office and work this out any kind of way. And, jestingly, Senator Haberman, I was going to ask, who won the fight? Senator Hall is literally eating raw meat, I thought I was tough...Senator Hall, you're the toughest man on this floor. I'm not going to ask that question. I'm sorry I even suggested it. (Laughter.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Any further discussion of the Hall-Preister amendment? Senator Preister.

SENATOR PREISTER: Thank you, Honorable President, friends all, I...since Senator Dierks is standing, if he would yield to a question.
